- Register appropriate Math course according to your placement.
- See the latest policy regarding A-Level courses.
- It is advised not to repeat the transferred course (s).
- Any course taken (including major) may fulfill the requirement and courses taken for Major will also count towards the requirements of General Education in that category and the credits will be counted towards Major.
